

Information for Submitting an Abstract and Poster
(updated September 29, 2009)

When submitting an abstract for the ASP 2010 Scientific meeting, please follow these instructions:

1. When submitting for the first time you will need to provide a log in and password
2. Abstracts should be no longer than **250 words**
3. You **MUST** submit your abstract using the template on the abstract site. Omitting the use of the template will cause your abstract to be hidden and will not show up online or be printed in the abstract book.
4. Place your abstract in the title you were invited to speak. If the title is not yet online, please place your abstract in the invited speaker title, your abstract will be moved to the correct symposia by the administrator. If you are submitting an offered paper as a non invited speaker, there is an offered paper title to place your abstract into. You will be contacted once your abstract has been accepted as an offered paper as to your date and time.
5. Posters are to be placed into the poster title. If you select either a poster or oral presentation, place your abstract into the poster session. Should you be selected to present an oral presentation, you will be contacted. **Poster size is limited to 4'x4'**. Posters will be given a poster number and should be hung on the poster board under the number assigned. Poster presentations will be presented using the poster number system. Posters may be submitted in addition to a presentation or by anyone registered for the meeting.
6. The abstract site will **close April 1, 2010**. Abstracts after that date, may not be published in the abstract book.
